ORDINANCE AMENDMENT NO. 01-2026

Please take notice that the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Centuria, Polk County, Wisconsin, has adopted an amendment to part of the Village Code, pertaining to Chapter 153 Animals.

Chapter 153 Animals is hereby recreated to read as follows:

1. Chapter 153 Animals

§ 153-3 to read as follows: Issuance of dog and multiple dog (kennel) licenses.

2. Removal of Chapter 153; § 153-3; Section B; Multiple-dog licenses

3. Chapter 153; § 153-16; Limitation on number of dogs and cats to read as follows:

A. Purpose. The keeping of a large number of dogs and cats within the Village of Centuria for a considerable amount of time detracts from and, in many instances, is detrimental to, healthful and comfortable life in such areas. The keeping of a large number of dogs and cats is, therefore, declared a public nuisance.

B. Number limited.

1. No person or family shall own, harbor or keep in its possession more than a total of three dogs or three cats, in any family dwelling unity, place of residence or business within the Village, and the keeping or harboring of more than three dogs and three cats is declared to be a nuisance, except that a litter of pups or kittens or a portion of a litter may be kept for not more than 10 weeks from birth.

~~2. The above requirements may be waived with the approval of the Village Board when a kennel license has been issued by the Village pursuant to 153.3B. Such application for waiver shall first be made to the Village Clerk-Treasurer.~~
