Discussion: Discussion and possible action on ordinances pertaining to §153.16 Limitation on number of dogs and cats. Surrounding residents were in attendance. Discussion on the clean, safe environment concerns, dogs getting loose, along with continuous noise issues. State license number 561231-DS, doing business as, and legal entity is different on the State of Wisconsin DATCP website from what was submitted to the village. Surrounding residents have stated that they have owned/harbored multiple dogs for more than 2 years, in such violating ordinance pertaining to §153.16.

A unanimous Chuck/Billy motion to deny the request for a multiple dog license based on discrepancies with information and disruption to the surrounding village residents.
